1-17 A BILL TO BE ENTITLED 1-18 AN ACT

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1-19 relating to the authority of a municipality to annex property in 1-20 certain water districts.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

SECTION 1. Section 43.071(e), Local Government Code, amended to read as follows:

- Subsections (b)-(d) do not apply to the annexation of: (e)
  - (1)an area within a water or sewer district if:
- (A) the governing body of the district consents to the annexation;
- (B) the owners in fee simple of the area to be annexed consent to the annexation; and
- (C) the annexed area does not exceed 525 feet in width at its widest point;
- (2) a water or sewer district that has a noncontiguous part that is not within the extraterritorial jurisdiction of the municipality; [or]
- (3) a part of a special utility district created or
- operating under Chapter 65, Water Code; or

  (4) a property by a municipality with a population of less than 3,000 if the governing body of a water or sewer district the boundaries of which include the property consents to the annexation.

1-41 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect September 1, 2023.

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
