2	relating to the establishment and operation of an interdisciplinary
3	group to review services provided by home and community support
4	services agencies.
5	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
6	SECTION 1. Chapter 142, Health and Safety Code, is amended
7	by adding Subchapter D to read as follows:
8	SUBCHAPTER D. INTERDISCIPLINARY GROUP MEETINGS
9	Sec. 142.101. DEFINITION. In this subchapter,
10	"interdisciplinary group" and "group" mean a group that meets on
11	the request of a home and community support services agency when
12	that agency identifies a need to discuss service delivery issues or
13	barriers to service delivery for a client served by the agency.
14	Sec. 142.102. MEMBERS OF INTERDISCIPLINARY GROUP. An
15	interdisciplinary group must include the following members:
16	(1) the client who is the subject of the
17	interdisciplinary group discussion, the client's representative,
18	or both the client and the client's representative;
19	(2) a representative of the home and community support
20	services agency that requested the interdisciplinary group
21	meeting; and
22	(3) a commission representative, who must be:
23	(A) a case worker or the case worker's designee;
24	(B) the applicable contract manager or contract

- 1 manager's designee; or
- 2 (C) the applicable regional nurse or nurse's
- 3 designee.
- 4 Sec. 142.103. INTERDISCIPLINARY GROUP MEETING REQUEST AND
- 5 SUSPENSION OF CLIENT SERVICES. (a) A home and community support
- 6 services agency may submit a request to the commission, in the form
- 7 and manner prescribed by the commission, for an interdisciplinary
- 8 group meeting for a client served by the agency.
- 9 (b) The commission must respond to a home and community
- 10 support services agency's request for an interdisciplinary group
- 11 meeting not later than 48 hours after the request is received by the
- 12 commission.
- 13 (c) Except as otherwise provided by this subsection, a home
- 14 and community support services agency may suspend the provision of
- 15 <u>services to a client until a requested interdisciplinary group</u>
- 16 meeting for that client is conducted and the group makes a final
- 17 determination regarding the provision of care to the client. This
- 18 subsection does not apply to a client who has priority status, as
- 19 determined by executive commissioner rule.
- Sec. 142.104. METHOD OF MEETING. (a) Except as provided by
- 21 <u>Subsection (b)</u>, an interdisciplinary group shall hold all meetings
- 22 <u>in person.</u>
- 23 (b) If holding an in-person interdisciplinary group meeting
- 24 is not possible, the group may hold the meeting through
- 25 videoconference. If neither an in-person meeting nor a meeting by
- 26 videoconference is possible, the group may hold the meeting by
- 27 telephone conference call.

- 1 Sec. 142.105. EFFECT OF MEETING. (a) Not later than the
- 2 fifth business day after the date of an interdisciplinary group
- 3 meeting, the commission shall:
- 4 (1) resolve any outstanding issues raised in the
- 5 meeting; and
- 6 (2) send a written notice to the home and community
- 7 support services agency that requested the meeting to notify the
- 8 agency that:
- 9 (A) not earlier than the second business day
- 10 after the date the agency receives the notice, the case created by
- 11 the meeting request will be closed; and
- 12 (B) the agency may respond with a request for an
- 13 additional meeting before the date the case is closed.
- 14 (b) The commission shall close a case not earlier than the
- 15 second business day after the date an agency receives notice
- 16 provided under Subsection (a)(2), if the agency did not request an
- 17 additional meeting in accordance with Subsection (a)(2)(B).
- 18 Sec. 142.106. NOTICE OF CLIENT'S PREVIOUSLY SUSPENDED
- 19 SERVICES. The commission shall notify a home and community support
- 20 services agency if:
- 21 (1) the agency provides services to a new client; and
- 22 (2) the client described by Subdivision (1) was the
- 23 subject of a previous interdisciplinary group meeting, and the
- 24 interdisciplinary group determination resulted in the client's
- 25 previous agency suspending services to the client.
- 26 SECTION 2. As soon as practicable after the effective date
- 27 of this Act, the executive commissioner of the Health and Human

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- 1 Services Commission shall adopt any rules necessary to implement
- 2 Subchapter D, Chapter 142, Health and Safety Code, as added by this
- 3 Act.
- SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2023.
