## A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

| 4  | BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:            |
| 5  | SECTION 1. Subtitle F, Title 4, Government Code, is amended        |
| 6  | by adding Chapter 490J to read as follows:                         |
| 7  | CHAPTER 490J. TEXAS AMMUNITION MANUFACTURING FACILITY              |
| 8  | SUBCHAPTER A. ESTABLISHMENT AND ADMINISTRATION OF TEXAS AMMUNITION |
| 9  | MANUFACTURING FACILITY   |
| 10 | Sec. 490J.001. DEFINITIONS. In this chapter:                       |
| 11 | (1) "Ammunition" means a combination of projectiles,               |
| 12 | cartridges, primers and propellants fired from a handgun or rifle. |
| 13 | (2) "Facility operator" means a person selected under              |
| 14 | Section 490J.002(d) to operate the facility.                       |
| 15 | Sec. 490J.002. TEXAS AMMUNITION MAUFACTURING FACILITY. (a)         |
| 16 | The Texas Ammunition Manufacturing Facility is established as an   |
| 17 | agency of this state within the Department of Public Safety.       |
| 18 | (b) The facility is established to manufacture quality             |
| 19 | ammunition for use by law enforcement for training and to ensure   |
| 20 | public safety and the general public for recreational shooting,    |
| 21 | hunting, self-defense and all other legal purposes as protected by |
| 22 | the Second Amendment to the United States Constitution.            |
| 23 | (c) The department shall have broad authority under this           |
| 24 | chapter and shall exercise close supervision over the facility to  |

- 1 promote and ensure integrity, security, honesty, and fairness in
- 2 the operation of the facility.
- 3 (d) The department may contract with or employ a person to
- 4 perform a function, activity, or service in connection with the
- 5 facility as necessary to implement this chapter, including but not
- 6 limited to the construction and operation of the facility.
- 7 Sec. 490J.003. POWERS AND DUTIES. (a) The facility
- 8 operator has the powers necessary to carry out the duties of this
- 9 chapter including the power to enter into contracts and other
- 10 necessary instruments.
- 11 (b) The facility operator shall manufacture quality
- 12 ammunition to be sold to law enforcement agencies at a reasonable
- 13 price.
- 14 (c) The facility operator shall sell ammunition to
- 15 ammunition wholesalers and retailers at a reasonable price.
- 16 (d) The facility operator may sell component parts of
- 17 ammunition to other ammunition manufacturers domiciled in Texas,
- 18 including projectiles, cartridges, primers and propellants.
- 19 (e) The facility operator may print the state seal, state
- 20 arms, or the state flag on packaging for ammunition manufactured by
- 21 the facility.
- 22 <u>(f) All ammunition manufactured by the facility must</u>
- 23 contain the words "Made in Texas" on the packaging.
- Sec. 490J.004. CERTAIN ACTIONS PROHIBITED. The facility
- 25 may not take any of the following actions:
- 26 (1) sell ammunition manufactured by the facility or
- 27 any component parts directly to consumers;

- 1 (2) sell ammunition or any component parts to foreign
- 2 countries.
- 3 Sec. 490J.005. RULEMAKING. The department may adopt rules
- 4 as necessary to implement this chapter.
- 5 Sec. 490J.006. TAXES. Ammunition sold by the facility to
- 6 <u>law enforcement agencies in Texas is not subject to state or local</u>
- 7 <u>sales and use tax.</u>
- 8 Sec. 490J.007. ANNUAL REPORT. The department shall submit
- 9 to the governor and the legislature a report on the status,
- 10 condition, operations, and prospects for the facility each year not
- 11 <u>later than December 1st.</u>
- 12 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 13 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 14 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 15 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 16 Act takes effect September 1, 2023.
