1-17 A BILL TO BE ENTITLED 1-18 AN ACT

1-19 relating to the operation of a motor vehicle at an intersection with 1-20 a stop sign. 1-21

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

SECTION 1. Section 544.010(c), Transportation Code, amended to read as follows:

(c) An operator required to stop by this section shall stop at a clearly marked stop line [before entering the crosswalk on the near side of the intersection]. In the absence of a clearly marked stop line [crosswalk], the operator shall stop before entering the
crosswalk on the near side of the intersection [at a clearly marked
stop line]. In the absence of a clearly marked stop line or crosswalk, the operator shall stop at the place nearest the intersecting roadway where the operator has a view of approaching traffic on the intersecting roadway.

SECTION 2. This Act takes effect September 1, 2023.
