 1-18 AN ACT

1-19 relating to the operation of a motor vehicle at an intersection with
 1-20 a stop sign.

1-21 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

1-22 SECTION 1. Section 544.010(c), Transportation Code, is
 1-23 amended to read as follows:

1-24 (c) An operator required to stop by this section shall stop
 1-25 at a clearly marked stop line [~~before entering the crosswalk on the~~
 1-26 ~~near side of the intersection~~]. In the absence of a clearly marked
 1-27 stop line [~~crosswalk~~], the operator shall stop before entering the
 1-28 crosswalk on the near side of the intersection [~~at a clearly marked~~
 1-29 ~~stop line~~]. In the absence of a clearly marked stop line or
 1-30 crosswalk, the operator shall stop at the place nearest the
 1-31 intersecting roadway where the operator has a view of approaching
 1-32 traffic on the intersecting roadway.

1-33 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect September 1, 2023.
