Section 19.02, Penal Code, is amended 5 by amending Subsection (b) and adding Subsection (e) to read as 6 follows: 7 (b) A person commits an offense if the person [he]: 8 intentionally or knowingly causes the death of an 9 (1)individual; 10 11 (2)intends to cause serious bodily injury and commits 12 an act clearly dangerous to human life that causes the death of an individual; [or] 13 14 (3) commits or attempts to commit a felony, other than manslaughter, and in the course of and in furtherance of the 15 commission or attempt, or in immediate flight from the commission 16 or attempt, the person [he] commits or attempts to commit an act 17 clearly dangerous to human life that causes the death of an 18 individual; or 19 (4) knowingly manufactures or delivers a controlled 20 21 substance listed in Penalty Group 1-B under Section 481.1022, Health and Safety Code, in violation of Section 481.1123, Health 22 23 and Safety Code, and an individual dies as a result of injecting, 24 ingesting, inhaling, or introducing into the individual's body any

1	amount of the controlled substance manufactured or delivered by the
2	actor, regardless of whether the controlled substance was used by
3	itself or with another substance, including a drug, adulterant, or
4	dilutant.
5	(e) It is a defense to prosecution under Subsection (b)(4)
6	that the actor's conduct in manufacturing or delivering the
7	controlled substance was authorized under Chapter 481, Health and
8	Safety Code, or other state or federal law.
9	SECTION 2. Section 481.141, Health and Safety Code, is
10	amended by adding Subsection (d) to read as follows:
11	(d) Punishment may not be increased under this section if
12	the defendant is also prosecuted under Section 19.02(b)(4), Penal
13	Code, for conduct occurring during the same criminal episode.
14	SECTION 3. The change in law made by this Act applies only
15	to an offense committed on or after the effective date of this Act.
16	An offense committed before the effective date of this Act is
17	governed by the law in effect on the date the offense was committed,
18	and the former law is continued in effect for that purpose. For
19	purposes of this section, an offense was committed before the
20	effective date of this Act if any element of the offense was
21	committed before that date.
22	SECTION 4. This Act takes effect September 1, 2023.
