PROTECTIVE HEADGEAR FOR AUTOCYCLE. 7 (a) In this section, "autocycle" means a motor vehicle, other than a 8 tractor, that is: 9 (1) designed to have when propelled not more than 10 three wheels on the ground; 11 equipped with seat belts and a steering mechanism 12 (2) [wheel]; 13 equipped with seating that does not require the 14 (3) 15 operator to straddle or sit astride the seat; and 16 (4) manufactured and certified to comply with federal safety requirements for a motorcycle. 17 For purposes of this chapter, an autocycle is considered 18 (b) to be a motorcycle, except that this chapter does not apply to an 19 autocycle that has a partially or fully enclosed cab. 20 21 SECTION 4. This Act takes effect September 1, 2023.
