12	category of alcoholic beverage at retail if the retail permittee or
13	<u>licensee</u> has not previously purchased that brand from that
14	wholesaler permittee or distributor licensee.
15	(b) The <u>liquor</u> or malt beverages provided as a sample under
16	Subsection (a) [wholesaler] may [give the retail permittee] not be
17	more than:
18	(1) 750 milliliters of any brand of distilled spirits;
