7	CHAPTER 226. LONG-TERM CARE FACILITY RESIDENT RIGHT TO ACCESS

9	Sec. 226.001. DEFINITIONS. In this chapter:
10	(1) "Long-term care facility" means:
11	(A) a facility licensed or regulated under
12	Chapter 242, 247, or 252, Health and Safety Code; or
13	(B) a state supported living center as defined by
14	Section 531.002, Health and Safety Code.
15	(2) "Prescription" includes an entry in the
16	compassionate-use registry established under Section 487.054.
17	Sec. 226.002. RESIDENT RIGHT TO ACCESS PRESCRIPTION
18	MEDICATION. A resident of a long-term care facility has a right to
19	access any medication for which the resident has a prescription
20	from a licensed practitioner, including a medication containing
21	<pre>low-THC cannabis.</pre>
22	SECTION 2. This Act takes effect September 1, 2023.
