2	(c) Not later than September 1, 2024, the secretary of state
3	shall prepare and submit a report on the study's findings to the
4	standing committees of each house of the legislature that have
5	jurisdiction over elections.
6	(d) This section expires September 1, 2025.
7	SECTION 2. This Act takes effect September 1, 2023.
