- Sec. 264.1078. LUGGAGE FOR FOSTER CHILDREN. (a) In this 8
- section, "luggage" means a suitcase, duffel bag, backpack, or 9
- similar container designed to hold an individual's personal 10
- belongings. 11

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- 12 (b) The department shall:
- 13 (1) establish and maintain a decentralized supply of
- 14 luggage to be used to transport a foster child's personal
- belongings; and 15
- (2) develop procedures for the storage and 16
- distribution of luggage to ensure the maximum number of children 17
- are able to use the luggage. 18
- (c) The department shall provide luggage to a child who is 19
- being removed from the child's home or changing placement. 20
- 21 (d) The department shall maintain a record of each time a
- trash bag is used to move a foster child's personal belongings. The 22
- 23 record must include the reason the department did not provide the
- child with appropriate luggage to move the child's personal 24

- 1 belongings.
- 2 (e) The department shall submit an annual report to the
- 3 legislature that includes a summary of:
- 4 (1) the number of times a trash bag was used to
- 5 transport a foster child's personal belongings and the reasons the
- 6 department failed to provide the child with appropriate luggage;
- 7 and
- 8 (2) the department's supply inventory and inventory
- 9 management practices for the luggage supply maintained under
- 10 Subsection (b).
- 11 (f) The department may solicit and accept gifts, grants, and
- 12 donations of any kind and from any source for purposes of this
- 13 <u>section</u>.
- 14 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect September 1, 2023.
