- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Section 82.002(c-1), Property Code, is amended
- 6 to read as follows:
- 7 (c-1) <u>Sections</u> [Section] 82.121 and 82.1142 apply [applies]
- 8 to a condominium for which the declaration was recorded before
- 9 January 1, 1994.
- 10 SECTION 2. Subchapter C, Chapter 82, Property Code, is
- 11 amended by adding Section 82.1142 to read as follows:
- 12 Sec. 82.1142. TABULATION OF AND ACCESS TO BALLOTS. (a)
- 13 Notwithstanding any other provision of this chapter or any other
- 14 law, a person who is a candidate in an association election or who
- 15 is otherwise the subject of an association vote, or a person related
- 16 to that person within the third degree by consanguinity or
- 17 affinity, as determined under Chapter 573, Government Code, may not
- 18 tabulate or otherwise be given access to the ballots cast in or
- 19 proxies submitted to the association for that election or vote
- 20 except as provided by this section.
- 21 (b) A person other than a person described by Subsection (a)
- 22 may tabulate votes in an association election or vote.
- 23 (c) A person who tabulates votes under Subsection (b) may
- 24 not disclose to any other person how an individual voted or to whom

- 1 an individual assigned their proxy.
- 2 (d) Notwithstanding any other provision of this chapter or
- 3 any other law, only a person who tabulates votes under Subsection
- 4 (b) may be given access to the ballots cast in or proxies submitted
- 5 to the association for the election or vote.
- 6 (e) This section may not be construed to affect a person's
- 7 <u>obligation to comply with a court order for the release of ballots</u>
- 8 or other voting records.
- 9 <u>(f) This section supersedes any contrary provision in a</u>
- 10 dedicatory instrument.
- 11 SECTION 3. Section 209.00594, Property Code, is amended by
- 12 amending Subsections (a), (b-1), and (c) and adding Subsection (e)
- 13 to read as follows:
- 14 (a) Notwithstanding any other provision of this chapter or
- 15 any other law, a person who is a candidate in a property owners'
- 16 association election or who is otherwise the subject of an
- 17 association vote, or a person related to that person within the
- 18 third degree by consanguinity or affinity, as determined under
- 19 Chapter 573, Government Code, may not tabulate or otherwise be
- 20 given access to the ballots cast in or proxies submitted to the
- 21 property owners' association for that election or vote except as
- 22 provided by this section.
- 23 (b-1) A person who tabulates votes under Subsection (b) or
- 24 who performs a recount under Section 209.0057(c) may not disclose
- 25 to any other person how an individual voted or to whom an individual
- 26 assigned their proxy.
- (c) Notwithstanding any other provision of this chapter or

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- 1 any other law, only a person who tabulates votes under Subsection
- 2 (b) or who performs a recount under Section 209.0057(c) may be given
- 3 access to the ballots cast in or proxies submitted to the property
- 4 <u>owners' association for</u> the election or vote.
- 5 <u>(e) This section supersedes any contrary provision in a</u>
- 6 <u>dedicatory instrument.</u>
- 7 SECTION 4. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 8 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 9 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 10 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 11 Act takes effect September 1, 2023.
