- 2 relating to a court requiring a defendant confined in a penal
- 3 institution to appear by videoconference in a criminal case.
- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Chapter 1, Code of Criminal Procedure, is
- 6 amended by adding Article 1.027 to read as follows:
- 7 Art. 1.027. PRESENCE BY VIDEOCONFERENCE. Notwithstanding
- 8 any other provision of this code, a court may require a defendant
- 9 without the defendant's consent to appear, for any proceeding
- 10 related to the prosecution of a criminal offense, by
- 11 videoconference in the manner described by Article 27.18 if the
- 12 defendant is confined in a penal institution at the time of the
- 13 proceeding.
- 14 SECTION 2. The change in law made by this Act applies only
- 15 to a criminal proceeding that commences on or after the effective
- 16 date of this Act. A criminal proceeding that commenced before the
- 17 effective date of this Act is governed by the law in effect on the
- 18 date the proceeding commenced, and the former law is continued in
- 19 effect for that purpose.
- 20 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2023.
