A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

AN ACT

2 relating to a school district's duty to notify certain parents or

3 guardians of a program providing students with reading disabilities

- 4 the ability to borrow audiobooks free of charge.
- 5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 6 SECTION 1. Section 28.006(g-2), Education Code, is amended
- 7 to read as follows:

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- 8 (g-2) In accordance with a notification program developed
- 9 by the commissioner by rule, a school district shall notify the
- 10 parent or guardian of each student determined, on the basis of a
- 11 screening under Section 38.003 or other basis, to have <u>a reading</u>
- 12 <u>disability or</u> dyslexia or a related disorder[, or determined, on
- 13 the basis of reading instrument results, to be at risk for dyslexia
- 14 or other reading difficulties, of the program maintained by the
- 15 Texas State Library and Archives Commission providing students with
- 16 reading disabilities the ability to borrow audiobooks free of
- 17 charge.
- SECTION 2. This Act applies beginning with the 2023-2024
- 19 school year.
- 20 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 21 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 22 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 23 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 24 Act takes effect September 1, 2023.
