4	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
5	SECTION 1. Chapter 442, Government Code, is amended by
6	adding Subchapter B-2 to read as follows:
7	SUBCHAPTER B-2. IWO JIMA MONUMENT AND MUSEUM
8	Sec. 442.065. DEFINITION. In this subchapter, "monument
9	and museum" means the Iwo Jima monument and museum at the Marine
10	Military Academy in Harlingen, Texas.
11	Sec. 442.066. IWO JIMA MONUMENT AND MUSEUM; FUND. (a) To
12	the extent authorized by law, the commission may enter into a
13	contract with the nonprofit entity that owns the monument and
14	museum to transfer to the commission the operation and management
15	of the monument and museum.
16	(b) The contract authorized by this section must include
17	provisions for:
18	(1) expanding, renovating, managing, maintaining,
19	operating, or providing financial support for the monument and
20	museum, including administration, construction and operation of a
21	visitor center and related activities;
22	(2) preserving military documents, relics, and other
23	items of historical interest;
24	(3) employing a director for the museum and other

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1 employees the commission considers necessary to fulfill its duties and responsibilities under the contract; 2 3 (4) accepting donations of money, property, and historical relics; and 4 5 (5) acquiring property and historical relics with funds available for that purpose. 6 7 (c) The Iwo Jiwa monument and museum fund is created as a 8 fund outside the state treasury. The commission shall administer the fund but may contract with the nonprofit entity that owns the 9 10 monument and museum for administration of the fund. The fund consists of: 11 12 (1) admissions revenue from the operation of the 13 monument and museum; 14 (2) sales revenue from the operation of the monument 15 and museum gift shop; and 16 (3) donations made to the commission for the monument 17 and museum. (d) Money in the Iwo Jiwa monument and museum fund may be 18 19 spent without legislative appropriation and only to administer, 20 operate, preserve, repair, expand or otherwise maintain the monument and museum. 21 (e) Interest and income from the assets of the Iwo Jiwa 22 monument and museum fund shall be credited to and deposited in the 23 24 fund. SECTION 2. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives 25 26 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this 27

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Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
Act takes effect September 1, 2023.
