9	"township" means a special district with territory that only
10	includes a census designated place, as designated by the United
11	States Bureau of the Census.
12	(b) This chapter applies to a person who:
13	(1) retires from:
14	(A) county employment in a county with a
15	population of 75,000 or more;
16	(B) employment by an appraisal district in a
17	county with a population of 75,000 or more;
18	(C) municipal employment in a municipality with a
19	population of 25,000 or more; [or]
20	(D) employment as a firefighter or emergency

or

medical services provider by an emergency services district located

wholly or partly in a county with a population of 150,000 or more;

(E) employment as a firefighter, police officer,

- 1 or emergency medical services provider by a township with a
- 2 population of 110,000 or more; and
- 3 (2) is entitled to receive retirement benefits from a
- 4 county, appraisal district, or municipal retirement plan, [or]
- 5 emergency services district, or township.
- 6 SECTION 2. (a) Chapter 175, Local Government Code, as
- 7 amended by this Act, applies according to its terms to all eligible
- 8 persons who leave employment with a township on or after January 1,
- 9 2024.
- 10 (b) A township that is required by Chapter 175, Local
- 11 Government Code, as amended by this Act, to provide continued
- 12 health benefits coverage but that is not allowed to provide the
- 13 coverage under the terms of the township's existing group health
- 14 plan shall ensure that the required continued health benefits
- 15 coverage is provided for in any new plan that is adopted by the
- 16 township on or after January 1, 2024, unless the township is
- 17 exempted under Section 175.007, Local Government Code.
- SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2023.
