A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

1 AN ACT

2 relating to the approval of beach access and use plans by the

- 3 commissioner of the General Land Office.
- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Section 61.015, Natural Resources Code, is
- 6 amended by amending Subsection (b) and adding Subsection (b-1) to
- 7 read as follows:
- 8 (b) Local governments shall submit proposed beach access
- 9 and use plans to the commissioner for certification as to
- 10 compliance with such policies and rules. The commissioner shall
- 11 act on a local government's proposed beach access and use plan
- 12 within 90 days of submission by [either] approving the plan,
- 13 partially approving the plan under Section 61.0151, or denying
- 14 certification.
- 15 (b-1) In the event of denial or partial approval under
- 16 Section 61.0151, the commissioner shall send the proposed plan or
- 17 unapproved portions back to the originating local government with a
- 18 statement of specific objections and the reasons for denial, along
- 19 with suggested modifications. On receipt, the local government
- 20 shall revise and resubmit the plan or unapproved portions. The
- 21 commissioner's certification of local government plans shall be by
- 22 adoption into the rules under Section 61.011.
- SECTION 2. Subchapter B, Chapter 61, Natural Resources
- 24 Code, is amended by adding Section 61.0151 to read as follows:

- 1 Sec. 61.0151. PARTIAL APPROVAL OF BEACH ACCESS AND USE
- 2 PLANS. (a) This section applies only to:
- 3 (1) a county having a population of more than 350,000
- 4 and less than 370,000 that borders the Gulf of Mexico and is
- 5 adjacent to a county having a population of 4.5 million or more; and
- 6 (2) a local government located wholly or partly in a
- 7 <u>county described by Subdivision (1).</u>
- 8 (b) The commissioner may partially approve a local
- 9 government's proposed beach access and use plan submitted under
- 10 Section 61.015. If the commissioner partially approves the
- 11 proposed beach access and use plan, the local government may submit
- 12 to the commissioner subsequent amendments only for the portions of
- 13 the beach access and use plan that are partially approved.
- (c) Amendments submitted under this section must be
- 15 <u>certified consistent with:</u>
- (1) Section 61.011 and rules adopted under that
- 17 section; and
- 18 <u>(2) Chapter 63.</u>
- 19 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 20 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 21 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 22 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 23 Act takes effect September 1, 2023.
