- 10 (A) a law enforcement agency, the Texas
- 11 Department of Motor Vehicles, a county tax assessor-collector, or a
- 12 criminal justice agency for an official purpose;
- 13 (B) an agency of this state investigating an
- 14 alleged violation of a state or federal law relating to the
- 15 obtaining, selling, or purchasing of a benefit authorized by
- 16 Chapter 31 or 33, Human Resources Code; [ex]
- 17 (C) an agency of this state investigating an
- 18 alleged violation of a state or federal law under authority
- 19 provided by Title 4, Labor Code; or
- 20 <u>(D) a private investigator licensed under</u>
- 21 Chapter 1702, Occupations Code, who is employed by a public
- 22 defender's office for an official purpose; or
- 23 (2) prevent a court from compelling by subpoena the
- 24 production of a person's photographic image.
