- 22 $\underline{\text{(D)}}$ [$\frac{\text{(A)}}{\text{(D)}}$] as a result of voluntarily entering on
- 23 active duty; or
- (2) active military service, as defined by Section

- 2 SECTION 2. Section 823.301(a), Government Code, as amended
- 3 by this Act, applies only to a member of the Teacher Retirement
- 4 System of Texas who retires on or after the effective date of this

- 6 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2023.
