

1 AN ACT

2 relating to the adoption by the Supreme Court of Texas of the
3 Uniform Interstate Depositions and Discovery Act.

4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

5 SECTION 1. Before September 1, 2025, the Supreme Court of
6 Texas may adopt the Uniform Interstate Depositions and Discovery
7 Act as rules of civil procedure.

8 SECTION 2. (a) Effective September 1, 2025, Section 20.002,
9 Civil Practice and Remedies Code, is repealed.

10 (b) If the Supreme Court of Texas adopts the rules described
11 by Section 1 of this Act with an effective date before September 1,
12 2025, those rules supersede Section 20.002, Civil Practice and
13 Remedies Code, to the extent of any conflict.

14 (c) Notwithstanding the repeal by this Act of Section
15 20.002, Civil Practice and Remedies Code, if the Supreme Court of
16 Texas does not adopt the rules described by Section 1 of this Act
17 before September 1, 2025, the substance of Section 20.002, Civil
18 Practice and Remedies Code, as that section existed immediately
19 before the effective date of this Act, is continued in effect.

20 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2023.
