A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

- 1 AN ACT
- 2 relating to Texas Fruit and Vegetable Day in public schools.
- 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 4 SECTION 1. Subchapter Z, Chapter 29, Education Code, is
- 5 amended by adding Section 29.9073 to read as follows:
- 6 Sec. 29.9073. TEXAS FRUIT AND VEGETABLE DAY. (a) The first
- 7 Friday in April is designated Texas Fruit and Vegetable Day in
- 8 public schools to promote awareness of the health benefits of
- 9 fruits and vegetables and to encourage students to consume more
- 10 fruits and vegetables during Texas Fruit and Vegetable Month under
- 11 Section 662.103, Government Code.
- 12 (b) Texas Fruit and Vegetable Day shall include appropriate
- 13 <u>instruction</u>, as determined by each school district.
- 14 (c) The agency may collaborate with other state agencies to
- 15 promote Texas Fruit and Vegetable Day.
- SECTION 2. This Act applies beginning with the 2023-2024
- 17 school year.
- SECTION 3. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 19 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 20 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 21 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 22 Act takes effect September 1, 2023.
