7	SECTION 1. Section 12.026, Title 2, Chapter 12 Texas
8	Natural Resources Code, is amended to read as follows:
9	Multiple Use of Land: "a tract of land purchased primarily

- 9 for a purpose authorized by this code may be used for any authorized 10 function of the department if the commission determines that 11 12 multiple use is the best utilization of the land's resources, including agreements with private entities for the purposes of 13 14 carbon sequestration using nature-based solutions on lands under the department's jurisdiction. Funds generated shall be deposited 15 in a specific fund and used solely for conservation of those lands 16 generating carbon credits. 17
- SECTION 2. Section 11.032(b), Title 2. Parks and Wildlife.
- 19 Chapter 11. Parks and Wildlife Department, Subchapter C, is amended
- 20 to read as follows:
- The department shall deposit to the credit of the game, fish,
- 22 and water safety account all revenue, less allowable costs, from
- 23 the following sources:
