## A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

2	relating to the manufacture of wine by the holder of a winery

4	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
5	SECTION 1. Chapter 16, Alcoholic Beverage Code, is amended
6	by adding Section 16.045 to read as follows:
7	Sec. 16.045. MANUFACTURING REQUIRED. (a) The holder of a
8	winery permit must be a bona fide winery actively engaged in the
9	manufacture of wine.
10	(b) The commission shall adopt rules necessary to implement
11	this section. Rules adopted under this section must provide:
12	(1) a reasonable amount of time after the issuance of a
13	winery permit for the permit holder to begin manufacturing wine;
14	<u>and</u>
15	(2) reasonable variances for crop failure or other
16	impediments to manufacture that are beyond the permit holder's
17	control.
18	(c) This section does not apply to the holder of a winery
19	permit:
20	(1) whose permit was issued:
21	(A) before March 7, 2023; or
22	(B) based on an application filed before March 7,
23	2023; and

- 1 (A) on March 7, 2023, was not actively engaged in
- 2 the manufacture of wine; and
- 3 (B) on or before December 31, 2023, files an
- 4 affidavit with the commission attesting to the fact that the permit
- 5 holder:
- 6 (i) was not actively engaged in the
- 7 manufacture of wine on March 7, 2023; and
- 8 <u>(ii)</u> does not intend to actively engage in
- 9 the manufacture of wine in the future.
- SECTION 2. (a) Section 16.045(a), Alcoholic Beverage Code,
- 11 as added by this Act, takes effect on the effective date of the
- 12 rules adopted by the Texas Alcoholic Beverage Commission under
- 13 Section 16.045(b), Alcoholic Beverage Code, as added by this Act.
- 14 (b) Rules adopted under Section 16.045(b), Alcoholic
- 15 Beverage Code, as added by this Act, must provide a reasonable
- 16 amount of time after the effective date of the rules for a holder of
- 17 a winery permit issued before the effective date of the rules to
- 18 begin manufacturing wine and otherwise come into compliance with
- 19 the rules.
- 20 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2023.
