- 16 (1) the defendant was the spouse of the child at the
- 17 time of the offense;
- 18 (2) the conduct was for a bona fide [educational,]
- 19 medical, psychological, psychiatric, judicial, law enforcement, or
- 20 legislative purpose; or
- 21 (3) the defendant is not more than two years older than
- 22 the child.
- SECTION 3. The changes in law made by this Act apply only to
- 24 an offense committed on or after the effective date of this Act. An

- 1 offense committed before the effective date of this Act is governed
- 2 by the law in effect on the date the offense was committed, and the
- 3 former law is continued in effect for that purpose. For purposes of
- 4 this section, an offense was committed before the effective date of
- 5 this Act if any element of the offense occurred before that date.
- 6 SECTION 4. This Act takes effect September 1, 2023.
