2 relating to the inclusion of a property in a conservation district

- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Subchapter A, Chapter 211, Local Government
- 6 Code, is amended by adding Section 211.0166 to read as follows:
- 7 Sec. 211.0166. EXCLUSION FROM CERTAIN CONSERVATION
- 8 DISTRICTS. (a) In this section, "conservation district" means a
- 9 local preservation district authorized by ordinance by a
- 10 municipality described by Subsection (b) to preserve, maintain, and
- 11 protect the physical elements of development and the community
- 12 character and heritage of neighborhoods having distinctive
- 13 <u>characteristics and patterns of development.</u>
- (b) This subsection applies only to a property located in a
- 15 municipality with a population of two million or more.
- 16 Notwithstanding any other law, this subsection applies regardless
- 17 of whether the municipality has established a process for
- 18 designating places or areas of historical, cultural, or
- 19 architectural importance and significance through the adoption of
- 20 zoning regulations or zoning district boundaries. The owner of a
- 21 property included within the boundaries of a conservation district
- 22 authorized by ordinance may elect to exclude the property from the
- 23 district by filing in the real property records for the county in
- 24 which the property is located an acknowledged statement:

- 1 (1) describing the property by reference to a map or
- 2 plat of the subdivision; and
- 3 (2) stating that the owner elects to have the property
- 4 excluded from the district.
- 5 (c) Subsection (b) does not apply to:
- 6 (1) the designation of a property as a local historic
- 7 landmark described by Section 211.0165(a); or
- 8 (2) the inclusion of a property within the boundaries
- 9 of a local historic district described by Section 211.0165(a).
- 10 (d) A statement filed under Subsection (b) must be filed
- 11 before the first anniversary of the date of the inclusion in a
- 12 conservation district. The exclusion of a property takes effect on
- 13 the filing of the statement by the owner of the property.
- 14 SECTION 2. Section 211.0166, Local Government Code, as
- 15 added by this Act, applies only to inclusion of a property within
- 16 the boundaries of a conservation district authorized by ordinance
- 17 after the effective date of this Act.
- SECTION 3. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 19 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 20 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 21 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 22 Act takes effect September 1, 2023.
