H.B. No. 4060

A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

1 AN ACT
2 relating to restrictions on eligibility to serve on the tax
3 appraisal district board of directors.

4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

5 SECTION 1. Section 6.035(a-1), Tax Code, is amended to read
6 as follows:

7 (a-1) An individual is ineligible to serve on the board of
8 directors of an appraisal district if the individual:

9 (1) has served as a member of the board of directors
10 for all or part of five terms, unless:

11 (A) the individual was the county
12 assessor-collector at the time the individual served as a board
13 member; or

14 (B) the appraisal district is established in a
15 county with a population of less than 120,000;

16 (2) has engaged in the business of appraising property
17 for compensation for use in proceedings under this title at any time
18 during the preceding three years;

19 (3) has engaged in the business of representing
20 property owners for compensation in proceedings under this title in
21 the appraisal district at any time during the preceding three
22 years; ~~[or]~~

23 (4) has been an employee of the appraisal district at
24 any time during the preceding three years;

1 (5) resigned; or

2 (6) was recalled under Section 6.033.

3 SECTION 2. Section 33.035(a-1), Tax Code, as amended by
4 this Act applies to an individual's eligibility to serve on the
5 board of directors of an appraisal district before, on, or after the
6 effective date of this Act.

7 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect on September 1, 2023.
