- 11 (A) the individual was the county
- 12 assessor-collector at the time the individual served as a board
- 13 member; or
- 14 (B) the appraisal district is established in a
- county with a population of less than 120,000; 15
- (2) has engaged in the business of appraising property 16
- for compensation for use in proceedings under this title at any time 17
- during the preceding three years; 18
- (3) has engaged in the business of representing 19
- property owners for compensation in proceedings under this title in 20
- 21 the appraisal district at any time during the preceding three
- years; [<del>or</del>] 22
- (4) has been an employee of the appraisal district at 23
- 24 any time during the preceding three years;

- 2 (6) was recalled under Section 6.033.
- 3 SECTION 2. Section 33.035(a-1), Tax Code, as amended by
- 4 this Act applies to an individual's eligibility to serve on the
- 5 board of directors of an appraisal district before, on, or after the
- 6 effective date of this Act.
- 7 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect on September 1, 2023.
