## A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

- 1 AN ACT
- 2 relating to the wearing of Native American tribal regalia or
- 3 objects of cultural significance at certain public school events.
- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Subchapter Z, Chapter 25, Education Code, is
- 6 amended by adding Section 25.902 to read as follows:
- 7 Sec. 25.902. NATIVE AMERICAN TRIBAL REGALIA AT CERTAIN
- 8 SCHOOL EVENTS. (a) A school district may not prohibit a student who
- 9 is a member of a Native American tribe from wearing traditional
- 10 tribal regalia or objects that have cultural significance to that
- 11 tribe, including feathers, beadwork, or tribal symbols, at a
- 12 graduation ceremony or other official school event.
- 13 <u>(b) In this section, "member of a Native American tribe"</u>
- 14 means an individual who is enrolled or eligible to be enrolled as a
- 15 member of a federally or state recognized American Indian or Alaska
- 16 Native tribe, band, nation, pueblo, rancheria, village, or
- 17 <u>community.</u>
- SECTION 2. This Act applies beginning with the 2023-2024
- 19 school year.
- 20 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 21 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 22 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 23 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 24 Act takes effect September 1, 2023.
