Section 27.0513(d), Water Code, is amended to read as follows: 6 Notwithstanding Sections 5.551, 5.556, 27.011, and 7 (d) 27.018, an application for an authorization or an amendment to an 8 9 authorization that allows the permit holder to conduct mining and restoration activities in production zones within the boundary 10 established in the permit is an uncontested matter not subject to a 11 12 contested case hearing or the hearing requirements of Chapter 2001, Government Code, if: 13 14 (1) the authorization is for a production zone located within the boundary of a permit that incorporates, for each 15 16 production zone addressed in the application, a range table of 17 groundwater quality restoration values used to measure groundwater restoration by the commission; 18 (2) the application includes, for each production zone 19 addressed in the application, groundwater quality restoration 20 values falling at or below the upper limit of the range established 21 in Subdivision (1); and 22 23 (3) the authorization is for a production zone located

(3) the authorization is for a production zone located24 within the boundary of a permit that incorporates groundwater

baseline characteristics of the wells for the application required
by commission rule.

3 SECTION 2. Sections 27.0513(f) and (g), Water Code, are 4 repealed.

SECTION 3. The change in law made by this Act applies only 5 6 to an application for an authorization or an amendment to an authorization that is submitted to the Texas Commission 7 on 8 Environmental Quality on or after the effective date of this Act. An application for an authorization or an amendment to an 9 authorization that was submitted to the commission before the 10 effective date of this Act is governed by the law in effect at the 11 time the application or amendment was submitted, and the former law 12 is continued in effect for that purpose. 13
