- 5 SECTION 1. Section 22.07, Penal Code, is amended by adding
- 6 Subsections (a-1) and (e-1) to read as follows:
- 7 (a-1) A person commits an offense if the person knowingly
- 8 sends a written message, including a text message, e-mail, social
- 9 media post, or other similar communication, to another:
- 10 (1) in which the actor threatens to cause bodily
- 11 injury to another person, including a threat to commit a mass
- 12 shooting or other act of terrorism; and
- 13 (2) that would cause a reasonable person to fear that
- 14 the actor might cause bodily injury to another.
- 15 (e-1) An offense under Subsection (a-1) is a Class A
- 16 misdemeanor.

- SECTION 2. Section 46.04(b), Penal Code, is amended to read
- 18 as follows:
- 19 (b) A person who has been convicted of an offense under
- 20 Section 22.01, punishable as a Class A misdemeanor and involving a
- 21 member of the person's family or household, or an offense under
- 22 Section 22.07(a-1), commits an offense if the person possesses a
- 23 firearm before the fifth anniversary of the later of:

- 6 SECTION 3. The change in law made by this Act applies only
- 7 to an offense committed on or after the effective date of this Act.
- 8 An offense committed before the effective date of this Act is
- 9 governed by the law in effect on the date the offense was committed,
- 10 and the former law is continued in effect for that purpose. For
- 11 purposes of this section, an offense was committed before the
- 12 effective date of this Act if any element of the offense occurred
- 13 before that date.
- 14 SECTION 4. This Act takes effect September 1, 2023.
