- 2 relating to the use of funds awarded under the Jobs and Education
- 3 for Texans (JET) Grant Program.
- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Section 134.004(b), Education Code, as amended
- 6 by Chapters 80 (S.B. 346) and 499 (H.B. 4279), Acts of the 87th
- 7 Legislature, Regular Session, 2021, is reenacted and amended to
- 8 read as follows:
- 9 (b) Grants may be awarded under this chapter from the Jobs
- 10 and Education for Texans (JET) fund:
- 11 (1) to defray the start-up costs associated with the
- 12 development of new career and technical education programs at
- 13 public junior colleges, public technical institutes, public state
- 14 colleges, and school districts and open-enrollment charter schools
- 15 described under Section 134.007 that meet the requirements of
- 16 Section 134.006; and
- 17 (2) to pay costs for the acquisition, implementation,
- 18 and ongoing maintenance of technology solutions necessary to
- 19 <u>support programs described by Subdivision (1)</u>.
- SECTION 2. Section 134.006(b), Education Code, is amended
- 21 to read as follows:
- 22 (b) A grant received under this section may be used only:
- 23 (1) to support courses or programs that prepare
- 24 students for career employment in occupations that are identified

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- 1 by local businesses as being in high demand, including courses
- 2 offered for dual credit;
- 3 (2) to finance initial costs of career and technical
- 4 education course or program development, including the costs of
- 5 constructing or renovating facilities, purchasing equipment, and
- 6 other expenses associated with the development of a new course;
- 7 [and]
- 8 (3) to finance a career and technical education course
- 9 or program that leads to a license, certificate, or postsecondary
- 10 degree; and
- 11 (4) to finance the acquisition, implementation, and
- 12 ongoing maintenance of technology solutions necessary to support a
- course or program described by Subdivision (1), (2), or (3).
- 14 SECTION 3. The change in law made by this Act applies only
- 15 to a grant awarded on or after the effective date of this Act.
- 16 SECTION 4. To the extent of any conflict, this Act prevails
- 17 over another Act of the 88th Legislature, Regular Session, 2023,
- 18 relating to nonsubstantive additions to and corrections in enacted
- 19 codes.
- 20 SECTION 5. This Act takes effect September 1, 2023.
