- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Subchapter Z, Chapter 29, Education Code, is
- 6 amended by adding Section 29.937 to read as follows:
- 7 Sec. 29.937. STATEWIDE LITERACY IMPROVEMENT PLAN. (a) The
- 8 agency shall develop a statewide plan for improving literacy among
- 9 public school students in partnership with one or more
- 10 organizations, such as Literacy First, that provide tutoring
- 11 services, one-to-one literacy interventions, teacher and staff
- 12 training, instructional coaching, and other supports related to
- 13 <u>improving literacy in early grades.</u>
- 14 (b) In developing the plan under Subsection (a), the agency
- 15 shall include:
- 16 (1) a draft budget for implementation of the plan; and
- 17 (2) a strategy that provides for a staggered
- 18 implementation of the plan that begins in schools identified by the
- 19 agency as having the most need for literacy improvement and is
- 20 gradually expanded to each school district and open-enrollment
- 21 <u>charter school in the state.</u>
- 22 SECTION 2. The Texas Education Agency shall develop the
- 23 statewide literacy improvement plan under Section 29.937,
- 24 Education Code, as added by this Act, as soon as practicable and not

- 1 later than September 1, 2024.
- 2 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 3 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 4 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 5 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 6 Act takes effect September 1, 2023.
