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A BILL TO BE ENTITLED AN ACT

1-19 relating to the packaging requirements for certain donated prescription drugs. 1-20 1-21

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

1-22 1-23 SECTION 1. Section 442.053(a), Health and Safety Code, is amended to read as follows:

1-24 (a) A donated prescription drug may be accepted or dispensed under this chapter only if the drug is in its original, unopened, 1-25 sealed, and tamper-evident <u>bottle</u>, <u>container</u>, <u>or</u> unit-dose packaging. A drug packaged in single unit doses may be accepted and dispensed if the outside packaging is opened but the single 1-26 1-27 1-28 1-29 unit-dose packaging is unopened.

1-30 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect September 1, 2023.

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
