1-19 relating to the packaging requirements for certain donated
 1-20 prescription drugs.

1-21 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

1-22 SECTION 1. Section [442.053\(a\)](#), Health and Safety Code, is
 1-23 amended to read as follows:

1-24 (a) A donated prescription drug may be accepted or dispensed
 1-25 under this chapter only if the drug is in its original, unopened,
 1-26 sealed, and tamper-evident bottle, container, or unit-dose
 1-27 packaging. A drug packaged in single unit doses may be accepted and
 1-28 dispensed if the outside packaging is opened but the single
 1-29 unit-dose packaging is unopened.

1-30 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect September 1, 2023.

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
