- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Subchapter A, Chapter 434, Government Code, is
- 6 amended by adding Section 434.029 to read as follows:
- 7 Sec. 434.029. CERTAIN VETERANS QUALIFIED FOR BENEFITS. (a)
- 8 <u>In this section</u>, "COVID-19" means the 2019 novel coronavirus
- 9 disease.
- 10 (b) For purposes of determining qualifications for any
- 11 veterans benefits or services from the state, a former member of the
- 12 <u>United States armed forces who received a less than honorable</u>
- 13 discharge due to the individual's refusal to receive a vaccination
- 14 against COVID-19 shall be considered to have received an honorable
- 15 discharge.
- 16 (c) For a discharge of a former member of the United States
- 17 armed forces to be considered honorable under Subsection (b), the
- 18 former member of the United States armed forces must prove to the
- 19 <u>Texas Veterans Commission that the individual's refusal to receive</u>
- 20 <u>a vaccination against COVID-19 was the sole reason for the</u>
- 21 individual's less than honorable discharge.
- 22 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 23 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 24 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this

- 1 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 2 Act takes effect September 1, 2023.
