- connection with a fraudulently or unlawfully obtained diploma, 3
- license, or other document. 4
- BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS: 5
- 6 SECTION 1. Section 301.454(a), Occupations Code, is amended
- to read as follows: 7

- 8 (a) Except in the case of a temporary suspension authorized
- under Section 301.455 or 301.4551, a summary annulment authorized 9
- under Section 301.4552, or an action taken in accordance with an 10
- 11 agreement between the board and a license holder, the board may not
- 12 take any disciplinary action relating to a license unless:
- 13 (1) the board has served notice to the license holder
- 14 of the facts or conduct alleged to warrant the intended action; and
- (2) the license holder has been given an opportunity, 15
- 16 in writing or through an informal meeting, to show compliance with
- all requirements of law for the retention of the license. 17
- 18 SECTION 2. Subchapter J, Chapter 301, Occupations Code, is
- amended by adding Section 301.4552 to read as follows: 19
- Sec. 301.4552. SUMMARY ANNULMENT FOR CERTAIN VIOLATIONS. 20
- 21 (a) Notwithstanding any other law, on receipt by the board of
- credible evidence that the holder of a license issued under this 22
- 23 chapter has violated Section 301.451(a)(1), (2), or (3), the board
- may annul the license without notice or hearing. 24

- 1 <u>(b) Immediately on the issuance of an order annulling a</u> 2 <u>license under this section, the board shall serve notice of the</u>
- 3 annulment, personally or by certified mail, on the individual whose
- 4 <u>license</u> is annulled. Service is complete and the annulment is
- 5 effective when the board personally serves the individual or sends
- 6 the notice.
- 7 (c) An individual whose license is annulled under this
- 8 section may request a hearing for the reinstatement of the license
- 9 not later than the 30th day after the date the order annulling the
- 10 license is issued. Not later than the 90th day after the date the
- 11 order was issued, the State Office of Administrative Hearings shall
- 12 hold the hearing to consider:
- 13 <u>(1) whether the individual violated Section</u>
- 14 301.451(a)(1), (2), or (3); and
- 15 (2) whether the annulment of the license is justified.
- 16 (d) In any proceeding in connection with an alleged
- 17 violation of Section 301.451(a)(1), (2), or (3), the license holder
- 18 has the burden of proving by a preponderance of the evidence that
- 19 the license was lawfully obtained if the license holder submitted,
- 20 as part of the license holder's application, a transcript, diploma,
- 21 or other document required for licensure that was issued or
- 22 purportedly issued by an entity that has been implicated in a scheme
- 23 of fraud relating to the issuance of transcripts, diplomas, or
- 24 similar documents.
- (e) An individual whose license is annulled under this
- 26 section may not apply for a license under this chapter until:
- 27 (1) the first anniversary of the date of issuance of

- 1 the order annulling the license under this section; and
- 2 (2) the applicant provides evidence that they have
- 3 completed a nursing education program meeting the requirements of
- 4 Texas Occupation Code section 301.157 and the Board rules
- 5 promulgated under that section.
- 6 SECTION 3. Section 301.4552(e), Occupations Code, as added
- 7 by this Act, applies only to a proceeding commenced on or after the
- 8 effective date of this act. A proceeding commenced before that date
- 9 is governed by the law in effect on the date the proceeding
- 10 commenced, and the former law is continued in effect for that
- 11 purpose.
- 12 SECTION 4. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 13 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 14 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 15 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 16 Act takes effect September 1, 2023.
