## A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

- 2 relating to a waiver of the waiting period for a marriage ceremony.
- 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 4 SECTION 1. Section 2.204(c), Family Code, is amended to
- 5 read as follows:
- 6 (c) An applicant may request a judge of a court with
- 7 jurisdiction in family law cases, a justice of the supreme court, a
- 8 judge of the court of criminal appeals, a county judge, [or] a judge
- 9 of a court of appeals, or a justice of the peace for a written waiver
- 10 permitting the marriage ceremony to take place during the 72-hour
- 11 period immediately following the issuance of the marriage license.
- 12 If the judge or justice finds that there is good cause for the
- 13 marriage to take place during the period, the judge or justice shall
- 14 sign the waiver. Notwithstanding any other provision of law, a
- 15 judge or justice under this section has the authority to sign a
- 16 waiver under this section.
- 17 SECTION 2. The change in law made by this Act applies only
- 18 to a marriage ceremony for which a marriage license application is
- 19 filed on or after the effective date of this Act. A marriage
- 20 ceremony for which a marriage license application is filed before
- 21 the effective date of this Act is governed by the law in effect on
- 22 the date the application was filed, and the former law is continued
- 23 in effect for that purpose.
- SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2023.
