H.B. No. 4184

A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

1 AN ACT  
2 relating to the removal from office of a member of the board of  
3 directors of certain special purpose districts.

4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

5 SECTION 1. Section 87.012, Local Government Code, is  
6 amended to read as follows:

7 Sec. 87.012. OFFICERS SUBJECT TO REMOVAL. The district judge  
8 may, under this subchapter, remove from office:

- 9 (1) a district attorney;
- 10 (2) a county attorney;
- 11 (3) a county judge;
- 12 (4) a county commissioner;
- 13 (5) a county clerk;
- 14 (6) a district clerk;
- 15 (7) a district and county clerk;
- 16 (8) a county treasurer;
- 17 (9) a sheriff;
- 18 (10) a county surveyor;
- 19 (11) a county tax assessor-collector;
- 20 (12) a constable;
- 21 (13) a justice of the peace;
- 22 (14) a member of the board of trustees of an  
23 independent school district; ~~and~~
- 24 (15) a county officer, not otherwise named by this

1 section, whose office is created under the constitution or other  
2 law of this state; and

3 (16) a director as defined by Chapter 49 and Chapter 54  
4 of the Water Code.

5 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives  
6 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as  
7 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this  
8 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this  
9 Act takes effect September 1, 2023.
