## A BILL TO BE ENTITLED 1 AN ACT 2 relating to educational materials regarding fentanyl substance 3 abuse. BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS: 4 5 SECTION 1. Subchapter B, Chapter 461A, Health and Safety Code, is amended by adding Section 461A.060 to read as follows: 6 7 Sec. 461A.060. FENTANYL SUBSTANCE ABUSE EDUCATIONAL MATERIALS. The department shall develop educational materials and 8 9 publish the materials on the department's Internet website to 10 educate parents and educators about: 11 (1) the dangers of consuming illegally manufactured 12 fentanyl; (2) recognizing the symptoms of a person experiencing 13 14 an opioid overdose; 15 (3) administering an opioid antagonist, as defined by 16 Section 483.101, to a person experiencing an opioid overdose; and (4) recognizing the signs of opioid dependency in an 17 adolescent. 18 SECTION 2. As soon as practicable after the effective date 19 of this Act, the Department of State Health Services shall publish 20 21 the educational materials on the department's Internet website as required by Section 461A.060, Health and Safety Code, as added by 22 23 this Act. SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2023. 24
