4	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
5	SECTION 1. Section 262.114, Family Code, is amended by
6	adding Subsection (a-3) to read as follows:
7	(a-3) The department shall record the results of a home
8	study performed under Subsection (a) in the department's electronic
9	case management system.
10	SECTION 2. Section 264.207, Family Code, is amended by
11	adding Subsection (b) to read as follows:
12	(b) The department shall record the results of a home study
13	performed under Subsection (a) in the department's electronic case
14	management system.
15	SECTION 3. Sections 262.114(a-3) and 264.207(b), Family
16	Code, as added by this Act, apply only to a home study performed on
17	or after the effective date of this Act. A home study performed
18	before the effective date of this Act is governed by the law in
19	effect on the date the home study was performed, and the former law
20	is continued in effect for that purpose.
21	SECTION 4. This Act takes effect September 1, 2023.
