A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

- 2 relating to the management and control of certain municipal

- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Subchapter G, Chapter 552, Local Government
- 6 Code, is amended by adding Section 552.1225 to read as follows:
- 7 Sec. 552.1225. TRANSFER OF MANAGEMENT AND CONTROL OF
- 8 ELECTRIC UTILITY SYSTEM OF CERTAIN MUNICIPALITIES. (a) A
- 9 municipality with a population of more than 750,000 that did not
- 10 transfer management and control of the municipality's electric
- 11 utility system to a board of trustees under this subchapter before
- 12 September 1, 2023, shall transfer management and control of the
- 13 <u>municipality's electric utility system to a board of trustees</u>
- 14 appointed by the municipality's governing body, except as provided
- 15 by Subsection (d).
- 16 (b) The board of trustees must include seven members who
- 17 serve staggered five-year terms. A person may not serve more than
- 18 two terms on the board of trustees.
- 19 <u>(c) To serve as a member of the board of trustees, a person</u>
- 20 must have at least 10 years of experience:
- 21 (1) in the administration of business or government;
- 22 (2) as a practicing attorney or certified public
- 23 accountant; or
- 24 (3) as a professional engineer in a field related to

- 1 electrical, nuclear, industrial, agricultural, architectural,
- 2 petroleum-related, chemical, power generation, or energy
- 3 transmission and distribution work.
- 4 (d) If the service territory of the municipal electric
- 5 utility includes at least four municipalities, the mayor of the
- 6 municipality in the service territory that has the greatest number
- 7 of retail customers is entitled to appoint four members to the board
- 8 of trustees, and the mayors of the remaining municipalities in the
- 9 service territory are entitled jointly to appoint the remaining
- 10 three members. The mayor of the municipality in the service
- 11 territory that has the greatest number of retail customers may
- 12 serve as a board member. Subsection (c) does not apply to that
- 13 mayor.
- 14 (e) The proceedings of the municipality may specify the
- 15 powers and duties of the board of trustees, the manner of exercising
- 16 those powers and duties, and any matter relating to the
- 17 organization and duties of the board. On any matter not covered by
- 18 the proceedings, the board of trustees is governed by the laws and
- 19 rules governing the governing body of the municipality in the
- 20 service territory that has the greatest number of retail customers,
- 21 to the extent applicable.
- 22 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect September 1, 2023.
