## A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

AN ACT

2 relating to the appointment and terms of members of a board of 3 trustees of a military reservation school district.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

5 SECTION 1. Section 11.352(b), Education Code, is amended to 6 read as follows:

7 (b) For each military reservation school district, the State Board of Education may appoint a board of three or five 8 9 trustees. Enlisted military personnel and military officers may be appointed to the school board. A majority of the trustees appointed 10 11 for the district must be civilians and all may be civilians. The 12 trustees shall be selected from a list of persons who are qualified to serve as members of a school district board of trustees under 13 Section 11.061 and who live on or are employed on the military 14 A person who retires from active duty or civilian 15 reservation. 16 service while serving a term as a member of the board of trustees may continue to serve for the remainder of that person's term. The 17 list shall be furnished to the board by the [commanding] officer who 18 is assigned to serve physically on the installation or military 19 reservation on which the military reservation school district is 20 located and who provides leadership for the functional support of 21 and contingency or emergency coordination for the military 22 23 reservation school district [of the military reservation]. The trustees appointed serve terms of three [two] years. 24

SECTION 2. The change in law made by this Act does not 1 affect the entitlement of a member serving on the board of trustees 2 of a military reservation school district immediately before the 3 4 effective date of this Act to continue to serve for the remainder of the member's two year term. As the terms of members expire, the 5 6 State Board of Education shall appoint or reappoint members to serve three year terms in accordance with Section 11.352(b), 7 Education Code, as amended by this Act. 8
