H.B. No. 4264

A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

1 AN ACT  
2 Relating to the eligibility of certain events for funding under the  
3 Major Events Reimbursement Program.

4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

5 SECTION 1. Section 478.0001(3), Government Code, as amended  
6 by Chapters 10 (H.B. 1472), 102 (S.B. 1265), 605 (S.B. 1155), and  
7 915 (H.B. 3607), Acts of the 87th Legislature, Regular Session,  
8 2021, is reenacted and amended to read as follows:

9 (3) "Event" means any of the following and includes  
10 any activity related to or associated with the following:

- 11 (A) the Academy of Country Music Awards;
- 12 (B) the Amateur Athletic Union Junior Olympic  
13 Games;
- 14 (C) a Big 12 Football Conference Championship  
15 game;
- 16 (D) the Breeders' Cup World Championships;
- 17 (E) a game of the College Football Playoff or its  
18 successor;
- 19 (F) the Confederation of North, Central America  
20 and Caribbean Association Football (Concacaf) Gold Cup;
- 21 (G) [~~(F)~~] a CONVRG conference;
- 22 (H) [~~(G)~~] an Elite Rodeo Association World  
23 Championship;
- 24 (I) [~~(H)~~] a Formula One automobile race;

1           (J) [~~(I)~~] the largest event held each year at a  
2 sports entertainment venue in this state with a permanent seating  
3 capacity, including grandstand and premium seating, of at least  
4 125,000 on September 1, 2021;

5           (K) [~~(J)~~] the Major League Baseball All-Star  
6 Game;

7           (L) [~~(K)~~] the Major League Soccer All-Star Game  
8 or the Major League Soccer Cup;

9           (M) [~~(L)~~] a mixed martial arts championship;

10          (N) [~~(M)~~] the Moto Grand Prix of the United  
11 States;

12          (O) [~~(N)~~] the National Association for Stock Car  
13 Auto Racing (NASCAR):

14                   (i) All-Star Race;

15                   (ii) season-ending Championship Race; or

16                   (iii) Texas Grand Prix race;

17          (P) [~~(O)~~] the National Basketball Association  
18 All-Star Game;

19          (Q) [~~(P)~~] a National Collegiate Athletic  
20 Association Final Four tournament game;

21          (R) [~~(Q)~~] the National Collegiate Athletic  
22 Association men's or women's lacrosse championships;

23          (S) [~~(R)~~] a national collegiate championship of  
24 an amateur sport sanctioned by the national governing body of the  
25 sport that is recognized by the United States Olympic Committee;

26          (T) [~~(S)~~] the National Cutting Horse Association  
27 Triple Crown;

1                   (U) [~~(T)~~] the National Hockey League All-Star  
2 Game;

3                   (V) the National Hot Rod Association Fall  
4 Nationals at the Texas Motorplex;

5                   (W) [~~(U)~~] a national political convention of the  
6 Republican National Committee or the Democratic National  
7 Committee;

8                   (X) [~~(V)~~] [~~a championship event in~~] the National  
9 Reined Cow Horse Association (NRCHA) Championship Series;

10                   (Y) [~~(W)~~] an Olympic activity, including a  
11 Junior or Senior activity, training program, or feeder program  
12 sanctioned by the United States Olympic Committee's Community  
13 Olympic Development Program;

14                   (Z) [~~(X)~~] a presidential general election  
15 debate;

16                   (AA) [~~(Y)~~] the Professional Rodeo Cowboys  
17 Association National Finals Rodeo;

18                   (BB) [~~(Z)~~] a Super Bowl;

19                   (CC) [~~(AA)~~] the United States Open Championship;

20                   (EE) [~~(BB)~~] a World Cup soccer game or the World  
21 Cup soccer tournament;

22                   (FF) [~~(CC)~~] the World Games;

23                   (GG) [~~(DD)~~] a World Wrestling Entertainment  
24 WrestleMania event; or

25                   (HH) [~~(EE)~~] the X Games.

26                   SECTION 2. Section 478.0001(7), Government Code, as amended  
27 by Chapters 10 (H.B. 1472), 102 (S.B. 1265), and 915 (H.B. 3607),

1 Acts of the 87th Legislature, Regular Session, 2021, is reenacted  
2 and amended to read as follows:

3 (7) "Site selection organization" means:

13 (H) [~~(G)~~] Dorna Sports;

14 (I) [~~(H)~~] the Elite Rodeo Association;

15 (J) [~~(I)~~] Encore Live;

16 (K) [~~(J)~~] ESPN or an affiliate;

17 (L) [~~(K)~~] the Federation Internationale de  
18 Football Association (FIFA);

19 (M) [~~(L)~~] the International World Games  
20 Association;

21 (N) [~~(M)~~] Major League Baseball;

22 (O) [~~(N)~~] Major League Soccer;

23 (P) [~~(O)~~] the National Association for Stock Car  
24 Auto Racing (NASCAR);

25 (Q) [~~(P)~~] the National Basketball Association;

26 (R) [~~(Q)~~] the National Collegiate Athletic  
27 Association;

1            (S) [~~(R)~~] the National Cutting Horse  
2 Association;  
3            (T) [~~(S)~~] the National Football League;  
4            (U) [~~(T)~~] the National Hockey League;  
5            (V) the National Hot Rod Association;  
6            (W) [~~(U)~~] the National Reined Cow Horse  
7 Association (NRCHA);  
8            (X) [~~(V)~~] the Professional Rodeo Cowboys  
9 Association;  
10           (Y) [~~(W)~~] the Republican National Committee;  
11           (Z) [~~(X)~~] the Ultimate Fighting Championship;  
12           (AA) [~~(Y)~~] the United States Golf Association;  
13           (BB) [~~(Z)~~] the United States Olympic Committee;  
14           (CC) [~~(AA)~~] World Wrestling Entertainment; or  
15           (DD) [~~(BB)~~] the national governing body of a  
16 sport that is recognized by:  
17                    (i) the Federation Internationale de  
18 l'Automobile;  
19                    (ii) Formula One Management Limited;  
20                    (iii) the National Thoroughbred Racing  
21 Association; or  
22                    (iv) the United States Olympic Committee.

23            SECTION 3. To the extent of any conflict, this Act prevails  
24 over another Act of the 88th Legislature, Regular Session, 2023,  
25 relating to nonsubstantive additions to and corrections in enacted  
26 codes.

27            SECTION 4. This Act takes effect September 1, 2023.
