8	"visual material" have the meanings assigned by Section 21.16,
9	Penal Code. In providing documentation in support of additional
10	reimbursement under Subsection (c)(1)(B), a health care provider or
11	sexual assault examiner may redact any personally identifiable
12	information of a sexual assault survivor and withhold any visual
13	material depicting a sexual assault survivor with the survivor's
14	intimate parts exposed or otherwise depicting the survivor in an
15	intimate state.
16	SECTION 2. Section 420.072, Government Code, is amended by
17	adding Subsection (a-1) to read as follows:
18	(a-1) For purposes of this subsection, "intimate parts" and
19	"visual material" have the meanings assigned by Section 21.16,
20	Penal Code. In disclosing a communication or record for purposes of
21	an audit, an evaluation, or research under Subsection (a)(5)(B), an
22	advocate or sexual assault program may redact any personally
23	identifiable information of a survivor and withhold any visual
24	material depicting a survivor with the survivor's intimate parts
