## A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

2 relating to the confidentiality of certain information maintained

- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Section 552.1176, Government Code, is amended by
- 6 amending Subsection (a) and adding Subsections (d) and (e) to read
- 7 as follows:
- 8 (a) Information <u>maintained under Chapter 81 is confidential</u>
- 9 and may not be disclosed to the public under this chapter if the
- 10 information:
- 11 (1) is a license application; or
- 12 (2) [that] relates to the home address, home telephone
- 13 number, electronic mail address, social security number, [ex] date
- 14 of birth, driver's license number, state identification number,
- 15 passport number, emergency contact information, or payment
- 16 information of an individual [a person] licensed to practice law in
- 17 this state [that is maintained under Chapter 81 is confidential and
- 18 may not be disclosed to the public under this chapter if the person
- 19 to whom the information relates:
- 20 [<del>(1) chooses to restrict public access to the</del>
- 21 information; and
- 22 [(2) notifies the State Bar of Texas of the person's
- 23 choice, in writing or electronically, on a form provided by the
- 24 state bar].

- 1 (d) Subsection (a) does not make confidential or except from
- 2 required public disclosure the name, state bar identification
- 3 number, membership class, or eligibility to practice law of an

- 7 over another law that authorizes or requires the release of
- 8 information maintained by the State Bar of Texas.
- 9 SECTION 2. Subchapter C, Chapter 552, Government Code, is
- 10 amended by adding Section 552.11765 to read as follows:
- 11 Sec. 552.11765. CONFIDENTIALITY OF CERTAIN INFORMATION
- 12 MAINTAINED BY STATE LICENSING AUTHORITY. (a) In this section,
- 13 "license" means a license, certificate, registration, permit, or
- 14 other authorization that:
- (1) is issued by a governmental body described by
- 16 Section 552.003(1)(A)(i); and
- 17 (2) an individual must obtain to practice or engage in
- 18 a particular business, occupation, or profession.
- 19 (b) Except as provided by Subsections (c) and (d),
- 20 information maintained by a governmental body described by Section
- 21 552.003(1)(A)(i) is confidential and excepted from the
- 22 <u>requirements of Section 552.021 if the information:</u>
- 23 <u>(1) is a license application; or</u>
- 24 (2) relates to the home address, home telephone
- 25 <u>number</u>, electronic mail address, social security number, date of
- 26 birth, driver's license number, state identification number,
- 27 passport number, emergency contact information, or payment

- 13 Human Resources Code, or Chapter 142, 242, 247, 248A, 250, or 252,
- 14 Health and Safety Code, Subsection (b) does not prohibit the

- 16 (1) the last four digits of the social security number
- 17 of a license holder in connection with a verification of
- 18 employability or an employee misconduct registry search provided by
- 19 the Health and Human Services Commission;
- 20 (2) a home address where activity regulated by the
- 21 licensing authority occurs; or
- 22 (3) an e-mail address or phone number associated with
- 23 <u>activity regulated by the licensing authority.</u>

- 2 Sec. 507.161. CONFIDENTIALITY OF HOME ADDRESS AND TELEPHONE
- 3 NUMBER. Except as provided by Section 507.160(d), the home address
- 4 and telephone number of a license holder are confidential and not
- 5 <u>subject to disclosure under Chapter 552, Government Code.</u>
- 6 SECTION 4. Section 552.1176(b), Government Code, is
- 7 repealed.
- 8 SECTION 5. The changes in law made by this Act apply only to
- 9 a request for public information received by a governmental body,
- 10 including the State Bar of Texas, or an officer for public
- 11 information on or after the effective date of this Act.
- 12 SECTION 6. This Act takes effect September 1, 2023.
