4	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
5	SECTION 1. Chapter 124, Government Code, is amended by
6	adding Section 124.008 to read as follows:
7	Sec. 124.008. RECIDIVISM STUDY. (a) In this section,
8	"council" means the Texas Judicial Council.
9	(b) The council, in collaboration with the Texas Veterans
10	Commission, shall conduct a study to evaluate the recidivism rate
11	of defendants who successfully completed a veterans treatment court
12	program in the preceding 10 years. The report must include:
13	(1) the recidivism rate, calculated by determining
14	from available information the percentage of defendants who have,
15	since completing the program:
16	(A) been arrested for an offense alleged to have
17	been committed after the defendant completed the program;
18	(B) been convicted of an offense committed after
19	the defendant completed the program;
20	(C) had a term of community supervision revoked
21	due to a technical violation or commission of another offense
22	committed after the defendant completed the program; and
23	(D) had a term of parole or mandatory supervision

revoked due to a technical violation or commission of another

- 1 offense committed after the defendant completed the program;
- 2 (2) any apparent patterns in the recidivism rate for
- 3 defendants based on the available information;
- 4 (3) a summary of any information the council
- 5 determines is correlated with or otherwise relevant to the
- 6 recidivism rate for defendants; and
- 7 <u>(4) recommendations for:</u>
- 8 (A) further action to improve outcomes for
- 9 defendants in the program; and
- 10 (B) program goals to reduce the recidivism rate
- 11 of defendants.
- 12 (c) The council may collaborate with any state or federal
- 13 agency, county, or court as necessary to obtain the information
- 14 described by Subsection (b).
- 15 (d) Not later than January 1, 2025, the council shall
- 16 prepare and submit to the governor and the legislature a written
- 17 report containing the results of the study and any recommendations
- 18 for legislative or other action.
- 19 (e) This section expires September 1, 2025.
- 20 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect September 1, 2023.
