- 7 (d) This subsection does not apply to an area in a
- 8 municipality's extraterritorial jurisdiction that is located
- 9 within five miles of a military base. A municipality that extends
- 10 its outdoor sign ordinance within its extraterritorial
- 11 jurisdiction may not enforce a prohibition on an outdoor sign in the
- 12 extraterritorial jurisdiction:
- 13 (1) unless the municipality adopts the ordinance
- 14 before the sign is placed; and
- 15 (2) until the municipality annexes in accordance with
- 16 Chapter 43 the property on which the sign is placed.
