5	SECTION 1. Section 261.204(b), Family Code, is amended to				
6	read as follows:				
7	(b) The report published under Subsection (a) must:				
8	(1) accurately represent all abuse-related and				
9	neglect-related child fatalities in this state, including child				
10	fatalities investigated under Subchapter F, Chapter 264, and other				
11	child fatalities investigated by the department; [and]				
12	(2) aggregate the fatalities by investigative				
13	findings and case disposition, including the following				
14	dispositions:				
15	(A) abuse and neglect ruled out;				
16	(B) unable to determine cause of death;				
17	(C) reason to believe abuse or neglect occurred;				
18	(D) reason to believe abuse or neglect				
19	contributed to child's death;				
20	(E) unable to complete review; and				
21	(F) administrative closure; and				
22	(3) aggregate the fatalities by cause of death, if				
23	determinable, including:				
24	(A) accidental drowning or submersion;				

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1		(B)	assault by drowning or submersion;
2		(C)	discharge of a firearm;
3		(D)	drug overdose;
4		(E)	assault by other physical means, including
5	strangulation or	suff	ocation;
6		(F)	accidental suffocation;
7		(G)	exposure to smoke, fire, or flames;
8		(H)	malnutrition;
9		<u>(I)</u>	deprivation of medical care;
10		(J)	motor vehicle accident;
11		(K)	heatstroke caused by being left in a motor
12	vehicle; or		
13		(L)	sudden infant death syndrome.
