## A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

1 AN ACT 2 relating to joint practice by certain health care professionals. 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS: SECTION 1. Sections 301.012(a-1), (a-2), (a-3), (a-6), and 4 5 (a-7), Business Organizations Code, are amended to read as follows: 6 (a-1) Persons licensed as physicians under Subtitle B, 7 Title 3, Occupations Code, [and] persons licensed as physician assistants under Chapter 204, Occupations Code, and persons 8 9 licensed as advanced practice registered nurses under Subtitle E, Title 3, Occupations Code, may form and own a professional 10 association or a professional limited liability company to perform 11 professional services that fall within the scope of practice of 12 13 those practitioners.

- 14 (a-2) A physician assistant <u>or an advanced practice</u>
  15 <u>registered nurse</u> may not be an officer in the professional
  16 association or limited liability company.
- 17 (a-3) A physician assistant or an advanced practice
  18 registered nurse may not contract with or employ a physician to be a
  19 supervising physician of the physician assistant or advanced
  20 practice registered nurse or of any physician in the professional
  21 association or limited liability company.
- 22 (a-6) A physician assistant, an advanced practice 23 registered nurse, or a combination of physician assistants or 24 advanced practice registered nurses may have only a minority

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- 1 ownership interest in an entity created under this section. The
- 2 ownership interest of an individual physician assistant may not
- 3 equal or exceed the ownership interest of any individual physician
- 4 owner. A physician assistant or combination of physician assistants
- 5 may not interfere with the practice of medicine by a physician owner
- 6 or the supervision of physician assistants by a physician owner.
- 7 (a-7) The Texas Medical Board, [and] the Texas Physician
- 8 Assistant Board, and the Texas Board of Nursing continue to
- 9 exercise regulatory authority over their respective license
- 10 holders according to applicable law. To the extent of a conflict
- 11 between Subtitle B, Title 3, Occupations Code, and Chapter 204,
- 12 Occupations Code, or any rules adopted under those statutes,
- 13 Subtitle B, Title 3, or a rule adopted under that subtitle controls.
- 14 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect September 1, 2023.
