- BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS: 4
- SECTION 1. Section 2210.454, Insurance Code, is amended to 5 read as follows:
- 7 MITIGATION AND PREPAREDNESS PLAN. (a) Subject to a plan
- approved by Tthe commissioner, shall annually the association may 8
- develop and implement administer a mitigation and preparedness
- 10 plan program.

- (b) Each state fiscal year, the department association may 11
- 12 fund the mitigation and preparedness plan program using available
- funds from the catastrophe reserve trust fund not to exceed 13
- 14 \$500,000 annually.
- 15 The mitigation and preparedness plan program must be
- designed provide for actions to be taken in the seacoast territory 16
- by the commissioner, or by a local government, state agency, 17
- educational institution, or nonprofit organization designated by 18
- the commissioner in the plan, to implement programs to: 19
- (1) improve preparedness for windstorm and hail 20
- 21 catastrophes; and
- 22 (2) reduce potential losses in the event of such a
- 23 catastrophe.; and
- 24 (3) provide research into the means to:

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- 2 (B) educate or inform the public in determining
- 3 the appropriateness of particular upgrades to structures; or
- 4 (C) protect infrastructure from potential damage
- 5 from those catastrophes.
- 6 (d) Money in excess of \$1 million may not be used under this
 7 section if the commissioner determines that an expenditure of
 8 investment income from the trust fund would jeopardize the
 9 actuarial soundness of the fund association or materially impair
 10 the ability of the fund association to serve the state purposes for
 11 which the fund association was established.
- 12 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect September 1, 2023.
